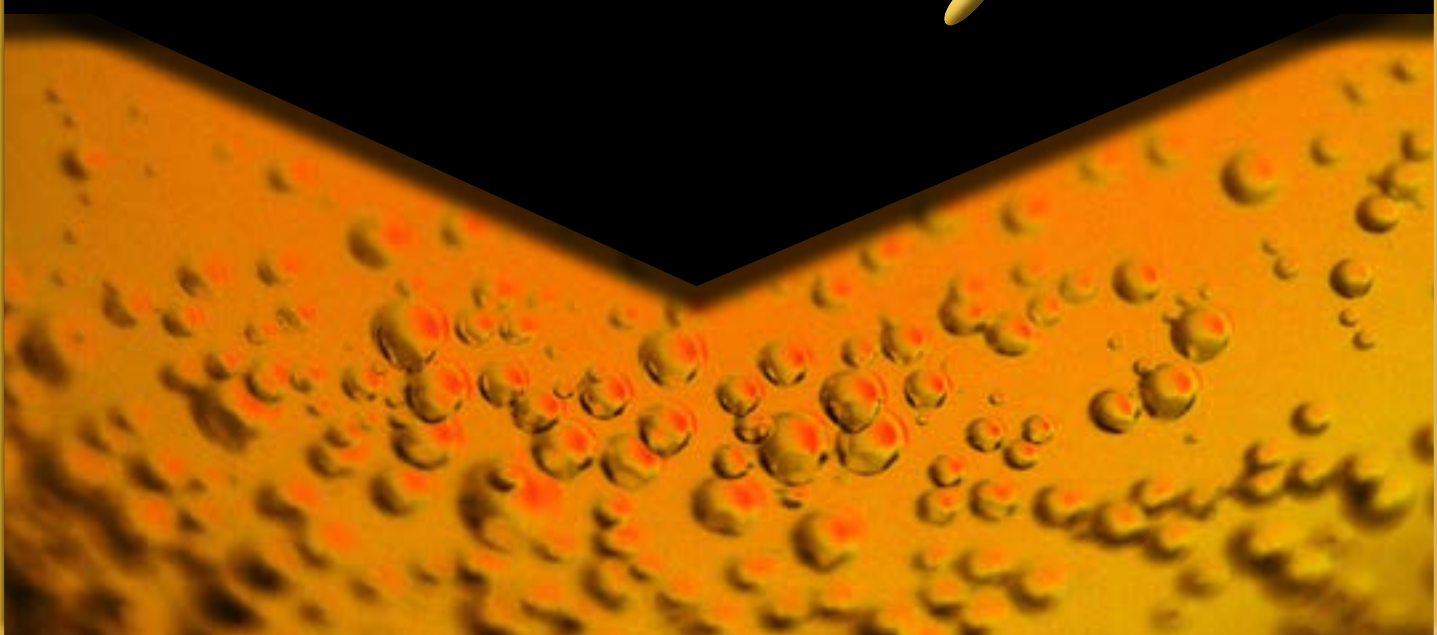


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BAR CONSIDERATIONS

LIQUOR PERMIT

- Event hosts must purchase the liquor permit and all alcohol
- SLGA Special Occasion Permits (SOP)
 - Most events require a SOP - Cost Recovery Permit
 - Not all events are eligible for a permit
 - Refer to [SLGA](#) website to find the permit that best suits your needs
 - Permits should be applied for at least +10 days prior to the event
 - Permit is to be displayed at the bar before liquor can be served
 - Alcohol receipts are required to be attached to your permit
- You must provide Mobile Mixers with a copy of your Liquor Permit prior to your event
- Individuals organizing the event and/or permit holder hold the liability
 - Consider purchasing Party Insurance

SAFE RIDES HOME

- All guests should have a safe ride when leaving the event
- Consider:

BARTENDERS RESPONSIBILITIES

- Serve It Right Saskatchewan Certified
- Server liability insurance
- Bar set up
 - 1 hour required
 - Supply bartending equipment
 - Pull alcohol and mix from storage
 - Put beverages on ice
 - Prepare garnishes
 - Organize the bar area
- Drink/ticket Sales
- Responsible drink service
 - Refuse liquor service to minors and overly intoxicated guests
- Maintain coffee/water/mix stations
- Table bussing
 - When time permits
- Bar teardown
 - Clean and organize bar area
 - Take out garbage and recycling

BAR REQUIREMENTS

- Bar area
 - o If no bar is available, 2-3 tables with tablecloths are required
 - o Recommend [A1 Party Store](#) for their selection of bar rentals
 - o Consider access and location to sinks
 - Garbage and recycle bins
 - Fridge, freezer, and/or coolers
 - o Required to store ice, canned beverages, champagne, and white wine
 - Disposable cups or glassware
 - o Short – 6 to 9oz
 - Great for wine and short highballs
 - o Tall – 12 to 16oz
 - Great for pop and tall highballs
 - o 1 oz shot glasses
 - Recommended if shooters will be served
 - Ice
 - o 2 – 3lbs/guest
 - o Extra required for coolers and beer tubs
 - Basic garnishes
 - o Lemons
 - o Limes
 - More limes over lemons
 - Having a beverage mixing station?
 - o Bartenders will maintain and restock it throughout the night
 - Bar equipment
 - o Please review the items that will be supplied by the bartenders
 - Bar mats
 - Beer tubs
 - Beer can openers
 - Bus pans
 - Cocktail shaker
 - Corkscrews
 - Cutting board
 - Garnish bowls
 - Glass rimmer
 - Gloves
 - Ice buckets
 - Ice scoops
 - Knife
 - Naloxone Kit
 - Serving tray
 - Shot glass (for measuring)
 - Speed pourers
 - Tip jar
 - Tongs
 - Towels
- Items below we can bring upon request**
- 6' tables
 - Cash box
 - Drink coolers
 - Drink menu w/ frame
 - Table cloths
 - Water dispenser
 - Water Pump

BEVERAGES

- Non-alcoholic options
 - o Pop, sparkling waters, lemonade, iced tea, punch, etc.
 - o Refer to our list of mocktail suggestions ([Page 9](#))
 - o Recommend a minimum of one non alcoholic beer and/or cooler
 - Beer= Corona Sunbrew, Bud Zero
 - Seltzer= White Claw 0%, Olé
- Water
 - o 3-gallon jugs w/pump
 - o Water bottles
 - o Pitchers filled with tap water
 - Consider access to sinks

- Hot beverages
 - o Tea
 - o Hot Chocolate
 - o Coffee
 - Keurig coffee maker with pods, sugar, and cream is a cheap option
 - BRWD Coffee Company mobile coffee bar is a fancy option
- Alcoholic options
 - o Use Mobile Mixer's Alcohol and Mix Purchasing Guide to help ([Page 5](#))
 - o Consider heavy drinkers and extra guests when ordering
 - o Post a menu outlining drink options and prices
 - Ask Mobile Mixers to have one designed, printed, and framed for you!
 - o Highly recommend Costco Liquor Store
- Wine
 - o Will wine be provided for each table? If so,
 - Will wine be placed on tables prior to guests arriving?
 - Will tables be provided with wine vouchers?
 - o Can guests purchase bottles of wine at the bar?
 - If so, how much? A bottle of wine serves 5 drinks.
 - o Consider having one red and one white option
 - o Consider options with twists off caps opposed to corks
 - o If possible, chill white and rose wines prior to the event starting
- Beer
 - o Consider offering a minimum of one light and one regular beer
 - Popular options are Coors Banquet, Coors Light, Pilsner, Bud Light, Busch
 - o Consider cans over kegs
 - Kegs tend to produce lots of waste and slow down serving time due to the pouring speed
- Coolers, hard iced teas, seltzer, and ciders
 - o Consider having a minimum of one cooler, hard iced tea, seltzer, and/or cider option
 - o Popular options:
 - Coolers = Mike's Hard, Smirnoff Ice, Black Fly, Palm Bay
 - Hard Iced Teas = Twisted Teas, Crush It's, American Vintage
 - Seltzers = Vizzy, White Claw, Dhillon's, Truly, Topo Chico, Nutri
 - Ciders = Okanagan, Somersby, Flatlander, Angry Orchid
- Highballs
 - o Most common options are Vodka, Spiced Rum, and Rye/Whiskey
 - o Less common options are Bourbon, Dark Rum, Gin, Scotch, Tequila, White Rum
- Shooters
 - o Refer to our list of Shooter suggestions ([Page 10](#))
 - o Consider having a minimum of one shooter option
 - o Without a shooter option guests will resort to shots of vodka or rye = messy!
- Specialty drinks
 - o Refer to our list of Cocktail suggestions ([Page 7](#))
 - o Consider additional supplies that may be required
 - Ex: specialty syrups, rimmers, and bitters
 - o If Caesars are being served, consider the supplies required
 - Tabasco
 - Worcestershire
 - Rimmer
 - Garnishes: pepperoni sticks, pickles, pickled asparagus, or celery

DRINK SALES

- Drink sales options
 - o Cash bar
 - o Ticket bar
 - o Open bar
 - o Donation bar
- Cash or ticket bars
 - Bartenders can handle ticket and drink sales
- Cost per drink
 - o Refer to your SLGA permit for guidelines
 - o Cost recovery permit charges
 - Max charge is \$3.00
 - o Will you charge for non alcoholic beverages?
 - If so, how much?
 - o Post a sign outlining drink prices
 - o Cash box required
 - o \$200 float in \$1, \$2, \$5, \$10, and \$20's

MENU DESIGN

- Mobile Mixers offers a free service where we can help design, print, and frame a drink menu for the evening of your event.
- Information regarding drink prices and what type of alcohol, cocktails, and shots must be received no later than one month prior to your event.

ALCOHOL & MIX PURCHASING GUIDE

HOW MUCH LIQUOR AND MIX SHOULD I BUY FOR THE BAR AT MY SPECIAL EVENT?

Most events run anywhere between 8 to 10 hours. During this time guests tend to drink approx. one to two drinks per hour, this typically includes around 3 beers, coolers, ciders, or seltzers, 3 mixed spirit drinks, and 1 glass of wine.

WINE

_____ Guests x 1 Glass of Wine each = _____ Glasses of Wine

A 750ml Bottle of Wine provides 5 drinks.

_____ Glasses ÷ 5 Glasses per 750ml Bottle = _____ of Bottles of Wine

BEER, COOLERS, CIDERS, OR SELTZERS

_____ Guests x _____ Cans each = _____ Cans of Beer, Coolers, Ciders, or Seltzers

A case contains 24 or 48 Cans of Beer, Coolers, Ciders, or Seltzers

_____ Cans ÷ 24 or 48 Cans per Case = _____ Cases (24 Pack) or _____ Cases (48 Pack)

SPIRITS

_____ Guests x _____ Glasses of Spirits each = _____ 1oz Glasses of Spirits

A 750mL bottle of spirit serves approx. 26 1oz shots

A 1.14 L bottle of spirit serves approx. 40 1oz shots

A 1.75 L bottle of spirit serves approx. 60 1oz shots

MIX PURCHASE CALCULATIONS

Most people will drink 2 mixed spirit drinks, and children will also have about 3 pops each.

A 2L Bottle of pop is approx. 66oz, which serves approx. six 12oz Drinks

_____ Drinks ÷ 6 drinks per 2L Bottle of Pop = _____ 2L Bottles of Pop

x _____ – Bottles of Coke or Pepsi

x _____ – Bottles of Diet Coke or Pepsi

x _____ – Bottles of Ginger Ale

x _____ – Bottles of 7-Up or Sprite

x _____ – Bottles of Soda Water

x _____ – Bottles of Tonic Water

Note: Cup size is important, you'll require more pop if using 16oz solo cups

OTHER ITEMS

- Cranberry Juice, orange Juice, clamato or other specialty juices
- Water
- Disposable cups or glasses
 - o Short – 6 to 9oz
 - o Tall – 12 to 16oz
 - o 1 oz shot glasses
- 1 Bag Lemons
- 1 Bag Limes
- Ice for drinks / coolers
 - o Approx. 2-3lbs of ice per guest
 - o _____ guests x 2-3lbs of ice = _____ lbs of ice
 - o Remember more ice is required to keep canned beverages cold throughout the night.
 - o You can never have too much ice, especially on a hot summer day!
 - o Recommend checking out [RJ's Ice & bottled water delivery](#)

IMPORTANT

The quantity and type of alcohol you'll need largely depend on your guests' preferences. For instance, if your guests enjoy beer or seltzers, consider providing a greater number of these drinks and fewer mixed spirits, or vice versa. Keep in mind any guests who prefer doubles. You know your guests best, so feel free to adjust accordingly.

The most popular choices include vodka, spiced rum, and rye/whiskey, while less common options are white rum, dark rum, tequila, gin, and bourbon. If you're planning a specialty cocktail, make sure to stock up on the specific spirit required.

Permit holders can return unopened bottles of spirits and wine, as well as sealed cases of beer and coolers, for a full refund at most locations. Just ensure the packaging is undamaged and bring the original receipt. We'll do our best to avoid opening boxes or bottles unnecessarily, so you can easily return any items if needed.
